Vaccination policy

At MPA, we prioritize the health and safety of all children under our care. Vaccination is a proven and effective way to prevent the spread of contagious diseases and protect the well-being of our community. In order to maintain a safe environment for all children, families, and staff, we have established the following vaccination policy:

Vaccination Requirement:

All children cared for at MPA must be up to date on their vaccinations according to the recommended immunization schedule established by the AAP (American Academy of pediatrics).

Exclusion of Unvaccinated Children:

New families who choose not to vaccinate their children will not be accepted as patients to MPA.

Verification of Vaccination Status:

Prior to establishing care, families must provide documentation of their child's vaccination status. This documentation should be in accordance with the immunization requirements set by the AAP (American Academy of pediatrics).

Alternative Vaccine Schedule:

Already established MPA families who opt for an alternative vaccine schedule must ensure that their child has completed the required vaccinations and is ready to attend school by the age of 3 years old. This request for an alternate schedule must be made clear to the provider by 1 year of age, and a plan for starting vaccinations will be documented and written into the patient's chart. Certain vaccines may be deferred or declined completely, depending on medical contraindications, or explicit conversations with the patient's provider. Once an alternative schedule is created, there will be no deviation from it unless medically deemed necessary by the provider. Failure to follow the developed alternative schedule will be a cause for dismissal from the practice.

Continued Communication:

MPA is committed to maintaining open and transparent communication with families regarding our vaccination policy. Any updates or changes to the policy will be communicated promptly to all enrolled families.

Promoting Community Health:

By adhering to this vaccination policy, we aim to create a safe and healthy environment for all children, staff, and families. We believe that maintaining high vaccination rates is a collective responsibility that contributes to the well-being of our entire community.
